If you reside in our catchment, have completed the enrolment paperwork (as well as submitted all of the relevant documents) and have attended an enrolment interview with us, then you're enrolled!



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There's also a variety of different events and activities we invite you to attend, so that you and your Prep child can get to know us and we can get to know you. When home and school work together, our students transition well to **Big School.**

Parents watch some information about our school on our iPADs and meet for a short time with our Deputy Principal to connect and share any important information about their child. This is parents and carers chance to hear about our school and about the Prep year of schooling. You will meet Ms Tracy Egan, our school principal at this event.
Term 4 – Various dates throughout <b>October and</b> <b>November</b> Parents and Carers need to follow the instructions sent by our Enrolments Officer, Ms Muncey to book into transition sessions using our online booking system.	<b>Transition Sessions</b> These are one hour visits for you and your child. The purpose is for your child to get to know the school environment and for you to connect with us, and other parents and carers, and hear information that will assist you to help your child transition well to school. The sessions last for one hour.	This is our chance to see a larger cohort of students, engage with each other and within our school environment. Seeing the students interact in larger groups helps us to create balanced class groups and allows us to see student interests. It helps us to plan the starting point for when we welcome them to school

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### Prep 2022 Student Transition Sessions

At 8.45 am – 9.45 am on the following dates, pre-Prep students are welcomed into our Prep classrooms while parents attend an information session. These parent information sessions are designed to meet the needs of incoming Prep parents and carers; we try to attend to questions and information you have shared throughout our interviews in Term 3.

*Please RSVP your attendance by booking the session you wish to attend via SOBs (the same booking process you completed at interview). Please call our enrolments officer, Kerry on 3482 8111 should you have any difficulties booking.* 

Between 8.30 and 8.45 am on the morning of your booked session, you will need to drop your pre-Prep aged student to our Prep precinct and sign them in. Your child should wear sun safe clothing, enclosed shoes and bring a labelled hat and water bottle with them.

If you or your child are unwell on the morning of the Transition Session, we ask that you do not attend and email our enrolments officer, <u>enrolments@mangohillss.eq.edu.au</u> to notify us you will not attend that day.

## Stay and Play Afternoons

In addition to our scheduled transition visits above, we invite families to attend two *Stay and Play* afternoons. This is a chance for parents and carers, and incoming Prep students to engage with each other, in a low-key play environment!

We ask that families supervise their own children at this event and where possible, prioritise the attendance of their pre-Prep child. When older and younger siblings attend these events, it can be tricky for your pre-Prep child to 'find their own way'. Meet us in the Prep Play Area on the following dates: Thursday 28 October and Thursday 18 November from 3.00 – 3.45 pm.

# Playgroup and Connecting with Us

We encourage you to attend our Playgroup, which runs each Friday morning during school terms from 9 am until 10 am (we meet in the Prep area towards the front of the school) and to follow us at our official Mango Hill facebook page. It's free! Come along and connect with other families. It's a great way to introduce your pre-Prep child to our school environment.

Miss Livvy is our playgroup facilitator and she organises engaging activities for families to enjoy each week.
